With scaffolding up to the top of the belltower we can do much needed repair work up there, fixing existing problems and preventing structural problems in the future. The restoration fund was intended for this type of major work on the church, and we are grateful for your kindness which enables us to do it. **The dome** will be repaired, sealed, and then felted over. **Faulty drainage** from the top will be repaired and worked around, all this solving the leaks into the interior of the tower. Major **repointing work** around the tower and the base, and all the way down the front of the church is necessary to preserve the structural integrity of the building. Finally, the eight old and damaged wooden **window frames and louvres** will be removed and replaced with new frames and fittings that **prevent pigeons entering**, and which blend into the tower's design.
