Dear Parishioners, All Peace & Good! I would like to begin by thanking everyone for your prayers, kindness and help. The evening of my induction your parish priest – from the Holy Mass through to the celebrations afterwards – could not have gone more wonderfully. An enormous amount of selfless work went into making our Church and Hall look so beautiful. A particular and heartfelt ‘thank you’ to everyone who helped with the cleaning, the sacristy, the cake and the celebrations afterwards.

Transparency and good stewardship Christ calls us to be ‘the light of the world and the salt of the earth’ (Matt. 5:13-16). Part of being ‘people who walk in the light’ means choosing to live lives that are accountable, transparent and responsible. Those who have been called to shepherd and guide Christ’s faithful must lead by example in this, and must be prepared to render an account of what has been entrusted to them. Since arriving in Liverpool, I have had many meetings at the Archdiocesan finance department. We are now very close to getting online banking for the parish accounts. After I liaise with the Parish Finance committee, it is my hope to be able to present to the parish, on a regular basis, not only the amounts in each of the parish accounts, but also how, exactly, this money is being used. Those who have been kind enough to give of their money to support the parish have a right to know how this money is being used and accounted for. It is my hope that, in the coming months, this will be a regular feature in our parish newsletter (or separate attachment).

Emails & phone calls to the parish Recently, it has become clear to me that more needs to be done to ensure that those who try to reach the parish (either via email or phone) can get through and can receive a prompt reply. Cheryl, the parish administrator, does an excellent job of staying on top of such communications but, as parish priest, I must make sure that I liaise with her in a manner that ensures that messages aren’t missed. This is a challenge as the parish (which currently has two email addresses) can receive, quite literally, hundreds of messages a week. Further, I only recently discovered that the parish phone doesn’t have an answering-phone facility. Those calling the parish are greeted with the message that ‘the mailbox is full’. However, the phones themselves have a technical error which doesn’t allow the mailbox to be opened. Last week, I changed our internet/phone provider, and next week a completely new phone system is being installed (with voicemail capability). I ask for your patience and prayers as we work to get everything in order.
